



2021 Kewaunee County Fairest of the Fair – Eligibility Requirements

- Contestant must be at least eighteen (18) years of age as of January 1, 2021.
- Contestant must have a valid Wisconsin driver's license with a good driving record.
- Contestant may not have been convicted of a felony act.
- The contest is open to individuals who are a resident of Kewaunee County, WI or who reside in an adjoining county if majority of fair and/or school activities are in Kewaunee County.
- Contestant must be available to attend Kewaunee County Breakfast on the Farm, all days of the Kewaunee County Fair, and 2022 Kewaunee County Fairest of the Fair Gala. Additional appearances and media interviews will be requested.
- The contestant agrees that the time, method, and manner of judging shall be solely within the discretion of the rules and regulations set forth by the Fairest of the Fair Committee and the Wisconsin Association of Fairs and that the decision of the judges shall be final.
- If selected as winner of the contest, contestant agrees not to sign a management contract with any individual or corporation, give written or verbal endorsement, make a personal appearance for any mercantile commodity or commercial organization, nor permit any photographs to be used without the written permission of the Fairest of the Fair Committee.
- If I am named as the Kewaunee County Fairest of the Fair/Fair Court, and for any reason do not fulfill the duties of this position for the entire term (one year), I will forfeit all cash prizes, scholarship monies, and other prizes that are awarded with the position. All of these awards will be returned to the Kewaunee County Fairest of the Fair Committee.
- If I am named as the Kewaunee County Fairest of the Fair, I will receive \$750 scholarship in two installments. The first installment will be distributed prior to state competition, and the second will be distributed at the 2022 Kewaunee County Fair Kickoff Dinner.
- Contestants will be required to dress in business or professional attire, accompanied by the sash and crown, as well as act in a business professional manner, while on duty promoting and representing the Kewaunee County Fair.
- If I am named as the 2021 Kewaunee County Fairest of the Fair, I will attend the Wisconsin State Fairest of the Fairs competition January 2022

- If I am named as the Kewaunee County Fairest of the Fair/Fair Court, and I am 21 years of age or older, I will NOT consume alcohol or use tobacco products while on official duty as the Kewaunee County Fairest of the Fair.

I, _____, understand the above rules and if I am named as the 2021 Kewaunee County Fairest of the Fair/Fair Court, I will abide by these rules. If I do not abide by these rules, I understand that the first runner-up will become eligible to be named the Kewaunee County Fairest of the Fair per the Fairest of the Fair Committee and Fair Board of the Kewaunee County Fair.
